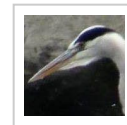

Description

This was the first of the 2013 Seasonal Walks from Great Harwood. This route includes the Dean Reservoir, the old milk farm, Billington Wood and back through the plantation. A great walk with amazing views as you descend to the reservoir and walk along the old bridleway. Lots of nesting birds in spring and the area is well maintained by United Utilities. Part of the walk is described in Walking the Footpaths of Great Harwood booklet. These walks stay within the Great Harwood boundary but the 'seasonal' walks ventured into neighbouring boroughs.
