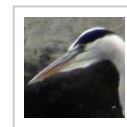

Description

This is a longer variation of the January Legstretcher 2014. It includes Harwood Bar Wood, the Baby Millennium Woodland managed by The PROSPECTS Foundation, a section of the Leeds Liverpool Canal from the Swing Bridge, part of the Ladybird Trail alongside Woodlands to Bell Lane, Clayton Forest Park, the River Hyndburn and the red bridge and back to the start. A popular local walk.

The Baby Millennium is worth a little detour to read the information board.

The woodland, next to St Mary's burial ground off Burnley Road, Altham, was the result of three years of hard work by the Prospects Foundation to plant a tree in honour of every Hyndburn baby born in 2000.
