

LOWERFOLD PARK'S best feature is its new play facilities for children aged 0 - 8 years and 8 - 14, these are located in 2 distinct areas linked by a ramp.

The bowling green and pavilion is used by Lowerfold Park Bowlers, when a bowling match is in operation the toilets within the pavilion are available to park users upon request. A bowling pass must be obtained to use the bowling green, this is free to residents of Hyndburn and £10.00 for a season for none Hyndburn residents. A bowling pass can be obtained by contacting 01254 388111.

A new rockery has been created by the play area as part of improvements to the park in 2011.

Access

The Children's play area and bowling green are on level ground if accessed from the middle Lowerfold Road entrance or from the Ash Street entrance. Unfortunately there are steps to access the tennis courts.

Parking

There are no car parking facilities within Lowerfold Park, however it is possible to park on Lowerfold Road outside the park gates.

Toilets

There are no public toilets in the park however a member of staff will open the works building upon request, this opportunity is only available during normal working hours when parks staff are within the park.
